

Nunkuwarrin Yunti is the largest Aboriginal community controlled health organisation in South Australia. We offer a wide range of primary health, social & emotional well being, health promotion and health training & development services to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

NUNKUWARRIN YUNTI DENTAL SERVICE

Nunkuwarrin Yunti Dental Service provides culturally appropriate dental care to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. The service ensures:

- People from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander backgrounds are supported;
- Clients have access to prevention and early intervention dental treatment; and
- Client rights and dignity are protected at all times.

The Dental Service is funded by the State Government through the SA Dental Service, as the government recognises the importance of providing a dental program that addresses a serious health issue for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

The Nunkuwarrin Yunti Dental Service provides emergency, restorative, routine and preventative oral health care.

WHERE TREATMENT IS AVAILABLE?

The Dental Service is currently available only at the Nunkuwarrin Yunti Wakefield Street site.

HOW MUCH WILL TREATMENT COST?

The service is provided free of charge.

WHO CAN USE THE DENTAL SERVICE?

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander adults and children who receive health services at Nunkuwarrin Yunti
- Non-Aboriginal people who are immediate family members of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander residents from rural and remote areas of Australia, who are temporarily residing in Adelaide for medical, educational, or other reasons



WHAT TREATMENT IS AVAILABLE?

We offer a number of treatments including:

- Oral hygiene advice & instruction
- Check-up, clean & treatment plan
- Dental x-rays
- Fluoride Treatment
- Fissure sealants
- Fillings
- Root canal therapy
- Extractions

WHAT IS NOT AVAILABLE?

- Orthodontics
- Dentures
- Implants
- Crowns or bridges
- Oral surgery

Clients needing these treatments will be referred to the appropriate dental service, such as the SA Dental Service, Adelaide Dental Hospital, or a private Orthodontist or Oral Surgeon.

APPOINTMENTS

Demand for the dental service is high, therefore it is necessary to make an appointment.

In an emergency, every effort will be made to see you as soon as possible.

The Dental Service is available 9am – 4:30pm Tuesday – Friday. Our Dental Assistant is also available on Mondays for advice and support only.

Tuesday afternoon appointments are reserved for children and teenagers between 2 - 17 years. It is necessary to make an appointment.

The Dental Assistant and Medical Reception provide an appointment reminder system for clients. All clients should advise the Dental Service as soon as possible if they cannot make their scheduled appointment.
